

TRAVEL REGULATIONS

Rules concerning car park

- Students must always use the **marked pedestrian crossings** when moving through the car park.
- Students using School buses must not walk across or stand in car parking spaces at any time. This applies particularly to girls waiting at the bus stop. They must wait on the concrete beside the bus stop.
- Students who arrive on early buses are to move immediately to the main part of the School and must not wait for friends at the bus stop or turning circle.
- The rules concerning the car park are devised for the safety of pedestrians. Drivers always have a responsibility to drive carefully and safely but pedestrians also have a responsibility to adhere to the rules set out above.

Behaviour expected of students travelling on School buses

- All students are expected to show courtesy and consideration for others and to behave responsibly in regard to the safety and property of others and themselves. This courtesy and consideration must at all times be shown towards the bus drivers.
- Before boarding the bus, students must have their student Opal pass ready to tap on or have the money to pay their fare.
- Students are to wear correct School uniform. In particular, if a jumper is worn, a blazer must also be worn.
- In keeping with School and bus company rules, **no food or drink is to be consumed on buses**. Any food or drink in the possession of students must be carried inside schoolbags.
- As a courtesy students must give up their seats, while travelling on their Pass, if there are insufficient seats for adult passengers. Students who refuse to give up their seats to adults will be reported by NSW Transit authorities, to their School. Repeat offenders risk having their Pass confiscated for a period of time.
