Should it be necessary to miss a training session or Saturday game (for example due to injury or illness), I will see that an 'Absence from Sport' form is completed and handed to Junior School reception. In some circumstance, a family member may be required to contact the Director of Sport if there is minimal time to give notice.
- I understand that I must be at my match 30 minutes prior to the start of my game.
- I understand a fee of \$90.00 will be charged at the time of online registration. This fee will contribute to the cost of coaching and the Saturday sport competition.
