To be eligible for the Tara Foundation (means-tested) Scholarship in Year 7, 2020 all candidates must:

- Be enrolled as a Year 6, 2019 student.
- Submit the most recent documentation supporting the family's income, including a statutory declaration as well as other evidence such as Parents' Group Certificates from 2017/2018.
- If awarded the Tara Foundation (means-tested) Scholarship, applicants will be expected to provide supporting documentation on the family's income on a yearly basis.

If your daughter meets the above criteria, please print this application form, attach the relevant supporting documentation and sign below verifying that she meets these requirements.
